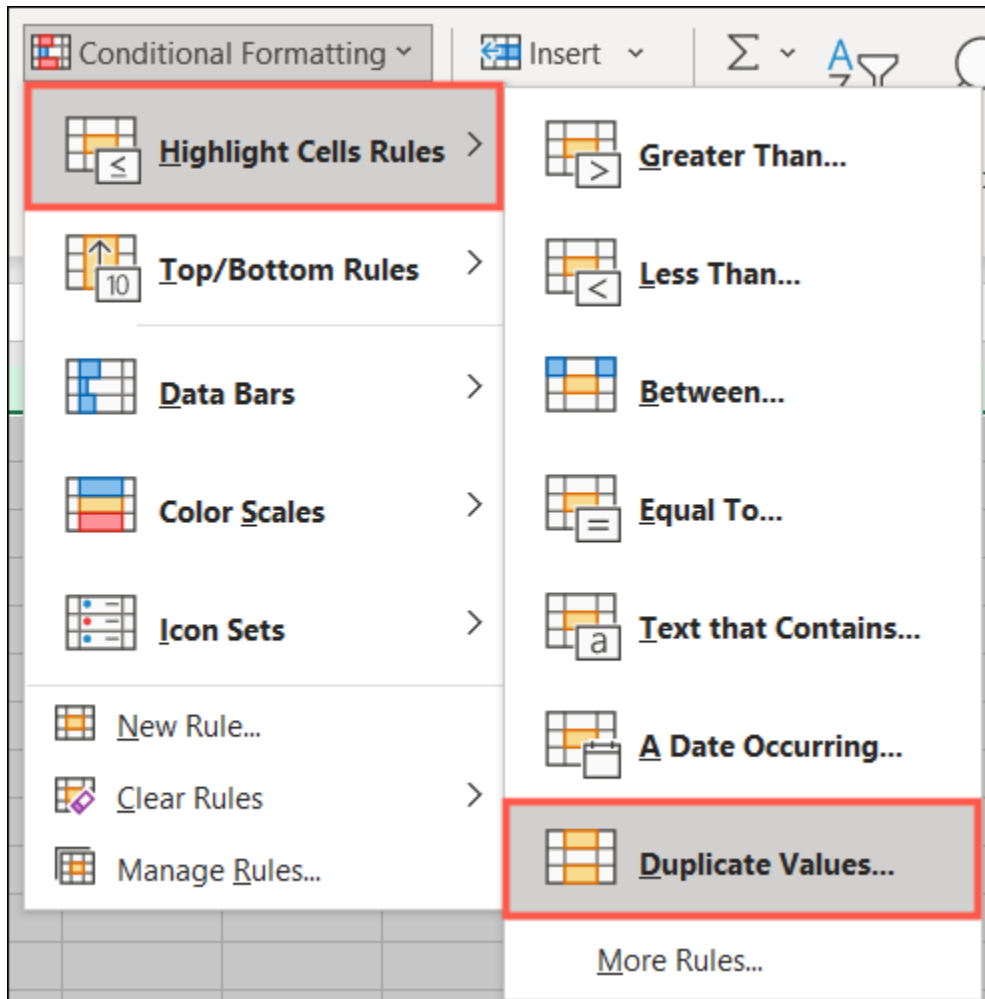


## How can I use conditional formatting in Excel to highlight duplicate entries?

1. Select the cells you want Excel to review for duplicates.
2. Go to the Home tab – Styles section. Click “Conditional Formatting” and choose “Highlight Cell Rules”, and then choose “Duplicate Values.”



You will be given the option to change the formatting of the duplicate value cells.
